
SARC is a national aeronautical research center hosted by LiU and funded by INNOVAIR, one of the first VINNOVA strategic innovation programs

Background

- Increased international competition makes it important to ensure Sweden's future competitiveness.
- It is crucial that we have a complete innovation system, from basic research, through demonstrators to products on the market.
- Collaboration between basic research (VR) and research on higher TRL levels (Vinnova) needs to be strengthened.
- Within basic aeronautical research, there is an increased need for research at low TRL levels at universities.
- As a leading strategy player INNOVAIR can facilitate increased collaboration between basic research and research at higher TRL levels



How can an aeronautical center at universities address this?

- A center can act collectively towards funding agencies and ministries to increase funding for basic aeronautical research and coordinate such funding
- A center of universities can bring together researchers focusing on different TRL levels
- University research has had a minor role during the startup of INNOVAIR and but is now becoming more prominent

What activities should such a center have?

- Activities for funding and focus point for basic aeronautics research
 - Discussions with VR, VINNOVA/INNOVAIR, Ministries, etc
 - National and international focus point where the main Swedish Aeronautics Universities can identify common issues
- Activities forstering synnergies
 - Annual conferences and workshops
 - Graduate school in basic aeronautics
 - Fostering international collaboration
 - Funding of research cooperation measures
 - Funding of basic research

SARC strengthens the research network

- All researchers funded by NFFP are naturally associated with the center
- SARC identifies additional researchers whose activities contribute to aeronautics
- Coordination of research and financing of TRL-raising activities
- Annual conferences, workshops and website puts the center on the map
- The position of aeronautics is strengthened at universities, as well as the possibility of additional funding for low TRL research
- Possible to extend to broader aeronautics activities and aerospace

SARC creates new collaborative arenas

- Centre gives Swedish universities an arena to strengthen internationalization
 - Initial focus on UK & Brazil
 - Both countries have strong academic focus on aeronautics
- The national Graduate school will prioritize activities that make international collaboration possible
 - International competitions (e.g. SAE BRASIL AeroDesign project)
 - Double degree programs
- Investigate possibilities for collaboration between master programs by e.g. course sharing:
 - Continued education & elective courses & 60 credit masters
 - Industry collaborative programmes
